

ESC ELECTIONS 2016 CODE OF CONDUCT

This document describes the code of conduct to be respected by candidates to an elective ESC Board position. It needs to be approved and signed by any candidate to an elective position.

- Candidates for elective positions at the ESC Board should refrain from canvassing activities such as travelling to meet Constituent Bodies for reasons not related to their current ESC activities or direct mailing / e-mailing to Constituent Bodies.
- Board members of the ESC and Past Presidents of the ESC should not campaign for any candidate to elective Board positions.
- In the case of serious bylaw violation on the part of the candidate, the Nominating Committee will examine the evidence and act accordingly.
- Candidates for President Elect position are allowed to present their manifesto at the Spring Summit during a 15-minute presentation.
- Their CVs and views will be posted on the ESC website next to their names.
- Candidates for other elective positions Vice President, Secretary-Treasurer, or Councillors - will have their CVs and objectives posted on the ESC website.

No other form of campaign activity is allowed during the election period, which starts with the official publication of the final slate to the end of the voting period.
